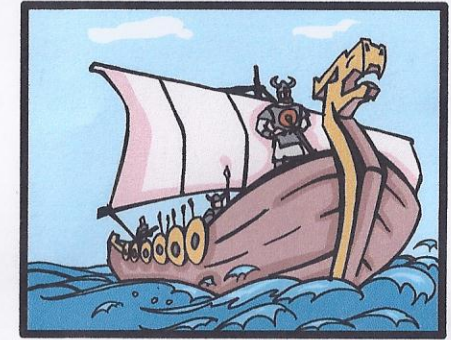
20 hours = \$120

Vikings Kingdom Environment

The environment in Vikings Kingdom is set up to meet the needs and interests of school-age children. It provides a safe, fun, and enriching place for the children to socialize with friends, while participating in large, small, or individual activities. We have a large gathering and block play area, a science and discovery area, an art area, a games and manipulative area, and a small library and rest area if your child feels like taking a break from it all! We also balance our indoor and outdoor play in our daily schedule. We offer a "study period" in Room 6 for children to complete homework where staff members will make every attempt to assist your child with questions about their assignments.
